

Memorandum of Understanding



The Office of the Communications Authority (OFCA) of Hong Kong and the Infocomm Media Development Authority (IMDA) of Singapore signed a MoU in Singapore in June. The MOU seeks to strengthen strategic collaboration and support the exchange of information between Hong Kong and Singapore in areas including regulatory practices, public education and development of technical solutions to address and mitigate issues relating to scam and spam communications, including calls and SMS messages. OFCA and IMDA have a fine tradition of conducting annual bilateral meetings since 2004. Over their 20-year close relationship, they have shared experience in the landscape and development of telecommunications markets, as well as regulatory and enforcement issues.
